OF SWISS TELESCOPE STATION (T4 = Euler)
LA SILLA OBSERVATORY / CHILE

- Our new young T4 station responsible technician, Michel JEANNERET (MJ), is now in Chile
- During the month of september, he received a detailed training for all the devices of Coralie spectrograph + CCD camera - C2 + Telescope T4 / Euler + computers / buildings / services / ...
- The successive missions of M.Jeanneret with M.Fleury, D.Megevand and D.Naef allowed to review all aspects of these instruments with him => mechanic, electronic, computers soft and hardware, observations, buildings and material maintenance
- Starting next month (October), he will be the privileged person in Chile for all contacts concerning the swiss station
- All issues, suggestions or remarks concerning instruments / telescope / building / observations / ... could be directly addressed to him
- He will be permanently in contact with Geneva (weekly report)
- As soon as he will have a new mobil phone number (~ nov-dec 2005), I shall communicate it to all observers => if MJ is not in La Silla, use this number for first level help
- The LSO missions schedule for swiss telescope provide the M.Jeanneret La Silla “on duty” exact time

- We rely on all observers to give MJ observation advises and tricks in order to improve his ability in astronomy, allowing him to become also a good observer in the future

- As very often we have difficulties to know in advance the name of the observer for your institut, Please, contact Michel Jeanneret by e-mail before your La Silla mission (if possible, a few days before)
- e-mail contact => michel.jeanneret@obs.unige.ch
- Specify the exact day of your La Silla arrival and if it is your first mission at swiss telescope
- In case of first mission at swiss telescope, it is very important to be at La Silla one day + night before your first night, in order to receive the last updated instructions and a training for observing
